

## Requirements for Issuance of Visa for Kenya

**Visas are issued strictly in accordance with the Kenya Visa Regulations 2010.**

1. A valid passport, which has a validity of at least six (6) months and enough space for the visa sticker
2. A set of duly completed and signed application form (**FORM 22**) for visa. Incomplete or incorrectly filled forms will automatically be rejected.
3. A set of photocopy of the applicant's passport, clearly showing passport number, its validity, photograph of holder, description and bio-data pages
4. Two (2) recently taken passport size photographs of the applicant
5. Invitation letter from the host or organization to be visited – the specific reason for applying for the visa ought to be clearly stated
6. Proof of financial ability (Bank Statement, Confirmed Return or On-ward air ticket) is necessary.
7. Application for ordinary visa should be submitted at least one (1) Week prior to travel date, whereas for referral visa at least two (2) weeks.
8. Vaccination against Yellow Fever and Cholera (not mandatory) are necessary
9. Revised Visa Fees:

Transit – US\$ 20

Single Journey – US\$ 50

Multiple Journeys – US\$100
